

Prevention Efforts

With support from a sister organziation, Race For Hope, funds were provided to the Columbus Free Clinic, in collaboration with The Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center, to provide no-cost colonoscopies to qualified individuals under the age of 45 without insurance or the ability to pay for the screening. Not only can a colonoscopy identify potentially precancerous polyps known as adenomas, but it also allows their removal.

An \$8000 donation provides for 10 colonoscopies.

Support of Research

The HMMCCF provided funds to the recently established Ohio State University Early Onset Colorectal Cancer Center and the research efforts of Dr. Matthew Kalady.

In addition, we launched the formation of our Beneficence Program and grant application process.
